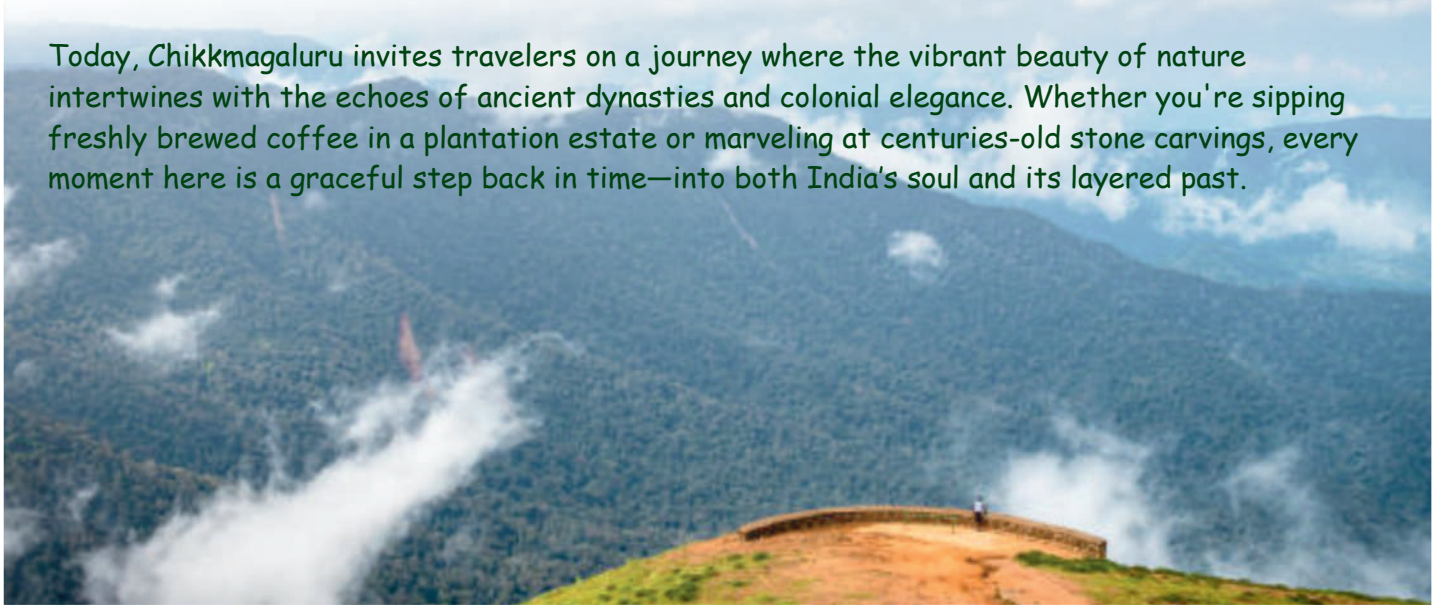

For nature lovers with a spiritual bent, Baba Budangiri is a must-visit. The cave shrine here is revered by both Hindus and Muslims, symbolizing the region's inclusive spirit.

While the misty hills and trails call to trekkers and wildlife enthusiasts, the town itself reflects its colonial past. Old British-era bungalows—now elegant homestays—line the hillsides, their wooden interiors and sprawling verandas echoing stories of the Raj. Iconic landmarks such as St. Joseph's Cathedral & the preserved administrative buildings subtly nod to this chapter of history.

Today, Chikkamagaluru invites travelers on a journey where the vibrant beauty of nature intertwines with the echoes of ancient dynasties and colonial elegance. Whether you're sipping freshly brewed coffee in a plantation estate or marveling at centuries-old stone carvings, every moment here is a graceful step back in time—into both India's soul and its layered past.

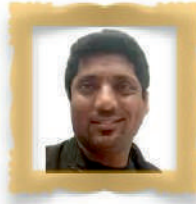

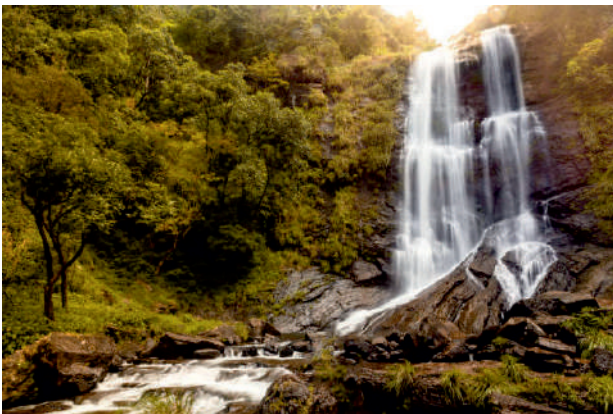

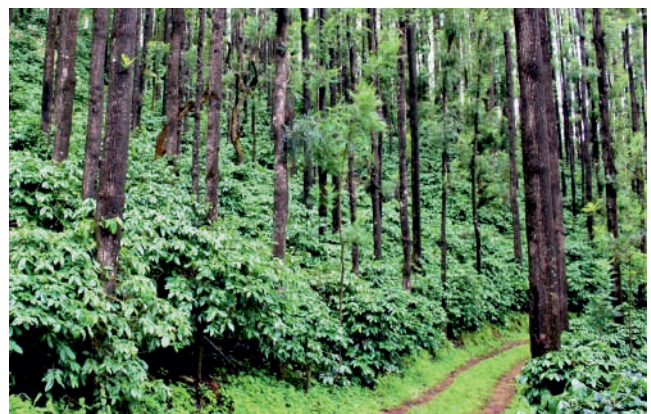
